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Cyflwyniad

Mae'n ofynnol i Gyrff Llywodraethol ysgolion a gynhelir gynhyrchu Adroddiad Blynyddol i rieni. Mae cynnwys yr adroddiad yn statudol, er gall Cyrff Llywodraethol ddewis ychwanegu gwybodaeth allai fod yn ddefnyddiol.

Ym mis Medi, roedd Mr Williams yn ei swydd fel Pennaeth dros dro.

Arhosodd disgyblion mewn swigod, ac nid oeddent yn gallu cymysgu ar draws dosbarthiadau oherwydd covid 19. Roedd yna ymlacio yn y rheolau gwisgo masgiau wyneb o fewn ystafelloedd dosbarth i'w groesawu, ac roedd staff bellach yn gallu teithio ar draws y ddwy ysgol. Parhaodd y defnydd o dechnoleg i gefnogi gweithio rhwng y ddwy ysgol, ac ar gyfer addysgu a dysgu rhwng y ddwy ysgol.

Roedd newidiadau staffio yn deillio o absenoldeb mamolaeth, salwch hirdymor ac absenoldebau covid yn heriau a oedd yn cael eu rheoli'n dda a'u cyfleu i rieni, gyda chyn lleied o aflonyddwch â phosibl i ddisgyblion. Rydym yn ddiolchgar i'r staff am gynnal safonau lles ac addysgu yn ystod cyfnod anodd.

Canlyniad annisgwyl covid oedd gwargedau iach yng nghyllidebau'r ddwy ysgol. Mae'r rhain wedi'u dyrannu i gynyddu adnoddau addysgu a gwella'r ardal allanol ar y ddau safle. Y gobaith yw defnyddio'r cyllid iyn gynnal lefelau staff gan sicrhau dim amhariaeth ar y dosbarthiadau a sicrhau profiad parhaus i'r plant.

O fis Medi 2022 bydd y Cwricwlwm newydd i Gymru yn orfodol. Mae staff wedi bod yn treialu ac yn cynllunio ar gyfer hyn dros y 3 mlynedd diwethaf. Bu'r holl randdeiliaid yn rhan o'r broses o gynllunio tuag at y Cwricwlwm newydd trwy holiaduron a thrafodaethau. Cryfder y Cwricwlwm a gyflwynir yn Ysgol Penrhyn-coch ac Ysgol Penllwyn yw ei phwyslais ar fod yn ddinasyddion Cymru. Parhaodd y disgyblion i fwynhau astudiaethau diwylliannol gan ddysgu am gymeriadau pwysig yn hanes Cymru ynghyd a'r ardal leol.

Er gwaethaf cyfyngiadau covid, cynhaliwyd sioe Nadolig llwyddiannus yn Ysgol Penllwyn trwywneud hynny yn yr awyr agored. Roedd yn anffodus bod cynnydd mewn achosion covid wedi achosi canslo cyngerdd awyr agored Penrhyn-coch. Da iawn i ddisgyblion a staff am addasu ar y funud olaf a chreu perfformiad ar-lein. Mae staff wedi defnyddio technoleg i weithio'n greadigol ac yn arloesol i barhau i gynnig profiadau cyfoethog i ddisgyblion y byddant yn eu cofio ymhell ar ôl eu dyddiau ysgol, er gwaethaf y cyfyngiadau.

Cynhaliwyd noson rieni ar-lein i gadw mewn cysylltiad â theuluoedd. Yn nhymor y Gwanwyn dychwelodd noson rhieni wyneb yn wyneb gydag adborth ardderchog am y modd y cawsant eu cynnal, fel modd o annog disgyblion i gymryd yr awenau ac i ddangos eu gwaith i'w rhieni.

Erbyn tymor y Gwanwyn dychwelydwyd i weithgareddau mwy arferol gyda theithiau lleol ac ymweliadau preswyl yn aildechrau. Roedd tymor yr Haf yn ymdebygu i dymor ysgol normal, a manteisiodd y disgyblion yn llawn ar y cyfle i gystadlu unwaith eto mewn chwaraeon tîm. Bu llwyddiant i ddisgyblion Ysgol Penrhyn-coch yn Eisteddfod yr Urdd ar lwyfan ac yng nghystadlaethau celf a chrefft.

Roedd diwrnod Mabolgampau'r ysgol yn ddigwyddiad arbennig o lawen eleni gyda'r ddwy gymuned o'r ddwy ysgol yn dod at eu gilydd yn gorfforol am y tro cyntaf ers ychydig dros 2 flynedd.

Ym mis Mehefin dychwelodd Miss Catryn Lawrence i'w rôl fel Pennaeth. Diolchwn i Mr Williams a Mr Davies am eu gwaith yn ei habsenoldeb, a diolch i Mrs Bethan Evans fel Dirprwy am eu cefnogi yn ei rôl. Rydym hefyd yn croesawu Miss Cory a Mrs Jones wedi eu cyfnodau mamolaeth.

Mae disgyblion a staff wedi dangos gwydnwch a gallu i addasu yn ystod blwyddyn o darfu gan nifer o ffactorau tu hwnt i'w rheolaeth. Gobeithiwn ddychwelyd yn gyflym i amodau mwy arferol y flwyddyn nesaf.

A word from the Chair, Rob Mills and the Vice-Chair, Gareth Hoskins

In September, Mr Williams was in post as acting head.

Pupils remained in bubbles, and were unable to mix across classes due to covid 19. There was a welcome relaxation in wearing facemasks within classrooms, and staff were now able to travel across both schools. Use of technology to support working between both schools, and for teaching and learning between both schools remained.

Staffing changes stemming from maternity leave, long term sickness and covid absences were challenges that were well managed and communicated to parents, with as little disruption as possible for pupils. We are grateful to the staff for maintaining moral and teaching standards during a difficult period.

An unexpected consequence of covid were healthy surpluses in both school budgets. These have been allocated to increasing teaching resources and improving the outdoor area on both sites. It is hoped that the use of funds to maintain staff levels means no further disruption to classrooms and a more continuous experience for the children.

From September 2022 the new Curriculum for Wales will be mandatory. Staff have been trialling and planning towards this over the last 3 years. All stakeholders were involved in the process of planning towards the new curriculum through questionnaires and discussions. A strength of the Curriculum delivered at Ysgol Penrhyn-coch and Ysgol Penllwyn is its emphasis on being citizens of Wales. Pupils continued to enjoy cultural studies learning about important characters in Welsh history.

Despite Covid restrictions, a successful Christmas show was held at Ysgol Penllwyn, having been able to do so outdoors. It was unfortunate that an increase in covid cases caused cancellation of Penrhyn-coch's outdoor concert. Well done to pupils and staff for adapting at the last minute and creating an online performance. Staff have used technology to work creatively and innovatively to continue to offer pupils rich experiences that they will remember long after their schools days, despite the restrictions.

Parents evenings were held online to maintain contact with families. The spring term saw the return of face to face parents evening with excellent feedback for the way in which they were held, as a means of encouraging pupils to take the lead and to show their work to their parents.

By the spring term there was a return to more normal activities with local trips and residential visits able to resume. The summer term resembled a more normal school term, and pupils took full advantage of the opportunity to compete once again in team sports. There was success for Ysgol Penrhyn-coch at the Urdd Eisteddfod on stage and in art and craft competitions.

School sport day was a particularly joyful event this year with both school communities being able to physically come together for the first time in just over 2 years.

June saw Miss Catryn Lawrence return to her role as Headteacher. We thank Mr Williams and Mr Davies for their work in her absence, and thanks to Mrs Bethan Evans for supporting them in her role as Deputy. We also welcome Miss Cory and Mrs Jones back at the end of the summer term.

Through a year disrupted by factors outside their control, pupils and staff have shown resilience and adaptability. We hope for a swift return to more standard conditions next year.

In close collaboration with the class teacher a teacher with responsibility for Additional Learning Needs identifies and arranges an appropriate programme of support for pupils according to their needs. Individuals and groups are given appropriate support within the classroom setting and specific support from specialist support staff. The school works very closely with the Local Authority and refers pupils who require further attention to Ceredigion County's Additional Needs Services.

Through robust assessment processes we hope to identify children's needs promptly, and provide an appropriate programme of support which enables them to succeed. This includes identifying pupils with disabilities, learning difficulties and More Able and Talented children. With parent's permission, each child's name is placed on the Additional Learning Needs register according to the stages described in the 'Welsh Additional Learning Needs Code of Practice'. It is the Authority's responsibility to provide a child with a Statement of Additional Educational Needs. The school plans a broad and balanced curriculum for pupils, providing suitable resources and support ensuring the best value from the monies allocated by the Local Authority. We monitor and review pupil progress continuously, adapting provision as required. Parents are kept fully informed of their child's development, and are invited to every review of progress meeting. Staff ensure that the toilets are not overcrowded by restricting the number of pupils who can use the toilets at any given time. Last year pupils planned and designed appropriate décor for the school toilets.

Bydd y cyfarfodydd yn agored i holl rieni o ddisgyblion cofrestredig yn yr ysgol, y Pennaeth ac unrhyw berson arall caiff eu gwahodd gan y Corff Llywodraethol. <i>Meetings will be open to all parents of registered pupils at the school, the headteacher and any other person invited by the Governing Body.</i>
5.	Rhaid i hysbysiad o gyfarfodydd i rieni gynnwys y dyddiad, amser a lleoliad y cyfarfod a'r mater(ion) i'w trafod. <i>Notification of meetings to parents must include the date, time and venue of the meeting and the matter(s) to be discussed.</i>

Rhaid i'r Corff Llywodraethol hysbysu'r rhieni'n flynyddol am yr hawl i gyflwyno deiseb am gyfarfod gan ddefnyddio'r pwerau a ddarperir gan Adran 94.

The Governing Body must inform parents annually of the right to petition a meeting using the powers provided by Section 94.

NEWIDIADAU I

GYFARFODYDD BLYNYDDOL Y RHINIEN / LLYWODRAETHWYR (2013)

Mae Adran 94 y Ddeddf Safonau a Threfniadaeth Ysgolion (Cymru) 2013 (y Ddeddf) yn gwneud newidiadau pwysig i'r trefniadau deddfwriaethol blaenorol oedd yn ymwneud â Chyfarfodydd Blynyddol y Rhieni/Llywodraethwyr. Mae'n darparu trefniadau newydd lle gall rhieni ofyn am gyfarfod gyda chorff llywodraethol.

Fodd bynnag, bydd angen i'r rhieni fodloni pedwar (4) gofyniad statudol wrth alw cyfarfod sef:-

- (i) rhaid i rieni 10% o'r disgyblion cofrestredig, neu rieni 30 o'r disgyblion cofrestredig (pa un bynnag sydd isaf) arwyddo deiseb yn gofyn am gyfarfod;
- (ii) rhaid mai diben y cyfarfod yw trafod materion sy'n ymwneud â'r ysgol;
- (iii) y nifer fwyaf o gyfarfodydd y gall rhieni ofyn amdanynt o fewn unrhyw flwyddyn ysgol yw tri (3);
- (iv) rhaid bod yna ddigon o ddiwrnodau ysgol ar ôl yn y flwyddyn ysgol i ganiatáu cyfarfod.

At hynny:-

- (a) rhaid cynnal y cyfarfodydd cyn diwedd cyfnod o 25 niwrnod;
- (b) mae'r cyfnod o 25 niwrnod yn cychwyn y diwrnod ar ôl derbyn y ddeiseb, ond nid yw'n cynnwys unrhyw ddiwrnod nad yw'n ddiwrnod ysgol;
- (c) os oes angen cynnal cyfarfod arall o ganlyniad i ddeiseb wahanol, ni fydd y cyfnod o 25 niwrnod yn dechrau tan y diwrnod ar ôl cynnal y cyfarfod arall;
- (ch) rhaid bod digon o ddyddiau ar ôl yn y flwyddyn ysgol i gynnal cyfarfod cyn diwedd y cyfnod o 25 niwrnod;
- (d) bydd cyfarfodydd yn agored i holl rieni'r disgyblion cofrestredig yn yr ysgol, y Pennaeth ac unrhyw un arall a wahoddir gan y corff llywodraethol;
- (dd) mae'n rhaid i hysbysiad y cyfarfodydd i'r rhieni gynnwys dyddiad, amser a lleoliad y cyfarfod ynghyd â'r mater neu faterion i'w trafod.

Bydd angen i gyrff llywodraethu roi gwybod i'r rhieni yn flynyddol am yr hawl i ddeisebu cyfarfod trwy ddefnyddio'r pwerau a ddarperir gan Adran 94.

CHANGES TO THE

ANNUAL PARENT/GOVERNOR MEETINGS (2013)

Section 94 School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013 (the Act) makes important changes to the previous legislative arrangements in respect of the Annual Parent/Governor Meetings. It provides new arrangements whereby parents can request a meeting with a governing body.

However, the parents will need to satisfy the four (4) statutory requirements when calling a meeting which are as follows:-

- (i) that the parents of 10% of registered pupils, or the parents of 30 registered pupils (whichever is the lower) must sign a petition requesting a meeting;
- (ii) the meeting must be for the purpose of discussing matters relating to the school;
- (iii) the maximum number of meetings that parents can request in any school year is three (3);
- (iv) there must be sufficient school days left in the school year to allow a meeting to be held.

Further:-

- (a) meetings must be held before the end of a 25 day period;
- (b) the 25 day period commences the day after receipt of the petition but does not include any day which is not a school day;
- (c) if another meeting is required to be held as a result of a different petition the 25 day period will not commence until the day after the other meeting has been held;
- (d) there must be sufficient days left in the school year to allow a meeting to be held before the end of the 25 day period;
- (e) meetings will be open to all parents of registered pupils at the school, Head and any other person invited by the governing body;
- (f) notification of meetings to parents must include the date, time and venue of the meeting and the matter or matters to be discussed.

Governing bodies will need to inform the parents annually of the right to petition a meeting using the powers provided by Section 94.
